

Sample Itinerary for 4 days / 3 nights

Baden-Baden – beautifully located at the foothills of the Black Forest – is a well-known spa & culture town, a city of elegant lifestyle and extensive parks and gardens. The city offers guaranteed relaxation in the two thermal spas, art and culture at the museums and Europe's second largest opera & concert hall, the Festival Hall Baden-Baden, as well as upscale shopping in the neo baroque old town. Challenging hours at Germany's most beautiful Casino and many sportive activities like hiking, mountain biking, paragliding or golfing in the Golfregion Baden-Alsace – the options are as manifold as classy. Excellent hotels, gourmet restaurants, small regional wine cellars and beautiful nature and stunning vistas await guests from all over the world in the "green city of short distances".

Day 1

Arrival at Frankfurt Airport and transfer to Baden-Baden by private shuttle or ICE direct train (1,5 hours).

OR

Arrival at Baden Airpark and transfer by private shuttle or taxi (30 minutes) to Baden-Baden.

Noon Check-in at the hotel.

Afternoon <u>Guided city tour</u> showing the highlights of Baden-Baden.

Afterwards

Visit of the Merkur Mountain.

From Baden-Baden's highest point, the Merkur Mountain, guests can enjoy breathtaking views over the Rhine Valley and the Black Forest with one of Europe's steepest funicular railways. A cozy restaurant on top of the mountain invites for a delicious break.

OR

Visit of the modern Caracalla Spa.

The Caracalla Spa located in the heart of the town offers relaxation and recreation. Guests can relax in the thermal bath surrounded by elegant marble columns and immerse themselves in the turquoise blue water of the inside pool below the glass dome.

Evening

Visit of an opera or a concert at the <u>Festival Hall Baden-Baden</u>. The Festival Hall Baden-Baden is Germany's largest opera and concert hall and hosts international opera, concerts and ballet throughout the year.

Day 2

Morning

Taking a ride in a **horse carriage**, along the parks and gardens "Lichtentaler Allee", a particularly romantic and extraordinary treat.

OR

Visit of the <u>Rose Society Garden</u> above town with a great variety of more than 600 different beautiful roses on display.

Noon

Lunch at one of many restaurants or wine taverns in town.

Afternoon

Take a walk in the beautiful surroundings of the vineyards of Baden-Baden's wine region "Rebland" (a 10-minute drive away from the city center).





Afterwards

Dinner in one of the gourmet restaurants or the cozy taverns at the **Rebland**.

Late Evening

Roulette, blackjack and poker await guests in Germany's oldest Casino. The <u>Casino Baden-Baden</u>, to some, the most beautiful casino of the world, rounds off a perfect day in a playful manner and entices guests to try their luck at the roulette table.

Day 3

Guests can choose one of the following **one-day excursions**:

Black Forest: Along the Scenic Road "Schwarzwaldhochstrasse" (B500) via Lake "Mummelsee" (35 minutes) to Freudenstadt (1 hour) and further to lake "Titisee" (2.5 hours), visit of a cuckoo-clock factory and shop, visit of the open-air museum in Gutach with typical Black Forest farmhouses and – gardens.

Strasbourg (France): is the intellectual and economic capital of Alsace and was chosen as the home of the European institutions. The exceptional architectural richness of Strasbourg has been classified as world heritage, a first time for a whole city centre.

Europa-Park: With a sensational mix of high-adrenaline rides, themed areas, beautiful parks, plus around 6 hours of shows every day, the resort ticks all the right boxes when it comes to fun and entertainment. (1-hour drive from Baden-Baden).

Rulantica (Europa-Park): The new indoor water world at the gates of The Europa-Park awaits its guests with 25 exciting attractions, including 17 water slides, a huge wave pool, a 250-meter lazy river and much more promise an unforgettable adventure for the whole family.

Castle tour: Discovering several castles in the region. Starting with the ruin of the Old Castle in Baden-Baden and continuing with the baroque Residential Palace followed by Germany's oldest "porcelain palace" the Favorite Palace in Rastatt (20 min drive).

Day 4

Morning

Visit of the <u>Museum Frieder Burda</u>. This museum offers an exclusive private art collection that includes selected masterpieces of the Classical Modernism.

OR

Enjoying a shopping trip in the picturesque streets and the small lanes of the neo-baroque, pedestrian only zones of the old town of Baden-Baden. Numerous exclusive boutiques invite to first-class shopping.

Noon

Transfer from Baden-Baden to Frankfurt Airport by private shuttle or ICE direct train (1,5 hours) and departure.

OR

Transfer from Baden-Baden to Baden Airpark transfer by private shuttle or taxi (30 minutes) and departure.
